What: The USCG Auxiliary, Whittier flotilla will be teaching this introductory safe boating class and offer local experience about boating in Prince William Sound.

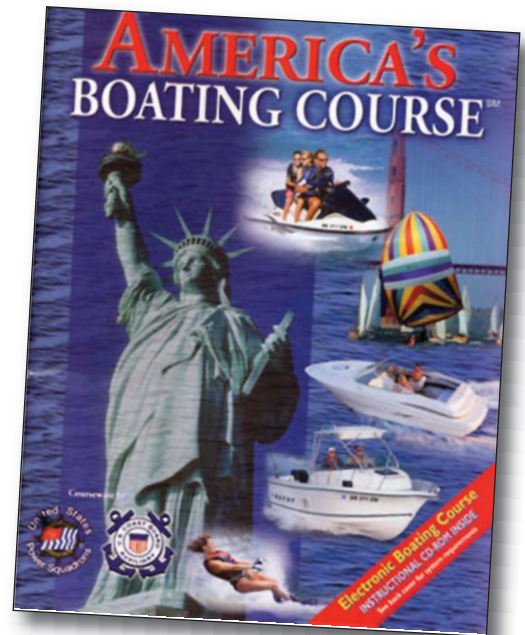
Cost: \$25 per student. If you share the book with your spouse the cost is only an additional \$10.
